RE: City Administrator – Follow Ups

The following are updates on previous inquiries from Council Members:

- 1. <u>Sidewalks:</u> starting up survey of residential sidewalks. Will include identifying raised slabs by tree roots.
- 2. <u>Community & economic Development</u> Meet & Greet with local businesses is Wednesday, April 3 from 4pm-6pm. Will be following up with local businesses to confirm that they have current business licenses.
- 3. <u>Bike Lanes</u> Jill Bahm and staff are working on gathering costs to prepare for a grant proposal.
- 4. Contract with Realtor (House in the Woods)
- 5. Contracts providing an update
- 6. <u>Lawn Cutting</u> received a proposal from a 2<sup>nd</sup> vendor. Did not offer a pricing advantage. Excell Landscaping is keeping the same pricing and added periodic clean up of the 696 Service Drive
- 7. Cell Town submitted counter proposal. Was not accepted. No further action.
- 8. <u>Dog Park</u> talked to Michigan DNR. This is an eligible project for their 3 funding sources. Must be added to the Recreation Master Plan. There will be a local match required, public hearing/posting, and resolution from City Council. Staff will be working on preparing to submit by the April 1, 2020 deadline.
