**Now You Can Recycle More!** - Effective July 1, 2008, residents of the SOCRRA communities can add new items to their curbside recycling bin.

- Glass bottles – All glass bottles, no matter the color, are now acceptable. In the past, only clear and brown were acceptable, but now residents can add green and blue bottles to the mix of recyclables.
- Aseptic containers – Residents can now add empty food and beverage boxes, milk cartons, paper cups, drink & juice boxes.
