

DOWNTOWN DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS SPECIAL BUDGET MEETING OF APRIL 24, 2020

1. Call to Order: By Chairperson Dan Sugg at 12:12 p.m.

2. Approval of the Agenda

Motion by Shermeyer, second by Lovins; approved unanimously on roll-call vote.

3. New Business

a. FY 20/21 Draft Budget

Bratschi stated that she received an email from the county regarding our settlement. She expects we will receive our funds around May 5^{th.} This deposit will make the DDA whole for this year, with the exception of personal property taxes. There were questions about the increases in the "salaries" and "training/membership" lines. Stec stated the changes are meant to increase transparency and better organize expenditures. "Salaries" now includes the portion of the Parks & Recreation Coordinator salary which was formerly under the "Farmers Market" line. There is significant coordination between the DDA and P&R, so this more accurately captures that. The "training/membership" includes memberships to Michigan Downtown Association (MDA), National Main Street Center (NMSC), and Michigan Association of Planning (MAP), as well as conference registration and travel fees. A portion of those funds were previously categorized under the "Main Street" line, which is now going to be our program fund (i.e. COVD-19 Business Assistance, Corridor Cleanups, Artisan Fair & Business BINGO.

Motion to accept and forward to council by Garrett, second by Lovins. Approved unanimously on a roll-call vote.



4. Public Comment

Prime asked when the next meeting will be. Stec stated Friday, May 15th at 12 Noon. A notice will be sent closer to the meeting date.
